The parties of the first part, for themselves and for their beirs, successors and assigns, covenant and agree that they will cooperate in the maintenance of the aforesaid lands as a waterflowly production area by not draining or permitting the draining, through the transfer of appurtenant water rights or otherwise, of any surface water including lakes, ponds, marches slouchs, swales, swamps, or potholes, now existing or resourcing due to natural causes on the above-described tract, by ditching or any other means; by not filling in with earth or any other material or leveling, any part or portion of the above-described tract on which surface water or much vertexion is now existing or hereafter enecuts due to ratural causes, and by soil turning any areas covered with much vegetation. 




