By signing the Terms of Agreement set forth below, the Participant acknowledges that a copy of any Appendix to the CRP-1 or GFP Conservation Reserve Enhancement Program has been provided to such person. Such person also agrees to pay such liquidated damages in the amount specified in the Appendix if the Participant withdraws prior to GFP acceptance or rejection. The terms and conditions of this contract are contained in the Terms of Agreement set forth below.
